

ENTRY CONDITIONS – VICTORIAN FARM SCULPTURE COMPETITION
12th Annual Victorian Farm Sculpture Competition
Wimmera Machinery Field Days 7th, 8th & 9th March 2017

1. Entries to be lodged on official entry form and returned to Victorian Farm Sculpture Competition Wimmera Field Days, via email: info@wimmerafielddays.com.au fax: 03 5384 7210 or post: PO Box 272, Horsham 3402. Entries close 12 noon Saturday March 4th 2017.
2. The person named on the entry must have created the sculpture themselves with limited assistance.
3. Included with the sculpture on display must be: Title of Sculpture and List of materials used.
4. Entries are limited to two sculptures per person in the open section and one sculpture per person per category in the feature categories.
5. Only people aged between 12-17 at the time of the Field Days can enter the Junior Sculpture Category.
6. Sculptures must be made from any old farming and second hand farm materials or new farm/agricultural materials or products. All materials and items must be typically found or used on a farm or be typical items used for general agricultural/farming rural living purposes.
7. Sculptures can take any form and be of any design. Sculptures do not necessarily have to depict a typical farm image or theme. Sculptures can be rough bush based design to modern Avant garde artistic creations or any theme or design of the sculptor's imagination.
8. (Wire and Corrugated Iron) Sculptures in the feature categories must be made predominantly from these materials other than small decorative pieces or parts to finish of the sculpture.
9. (Small Sculpture) Sculptures in the feature category must be max size of 50cm (HxLxW).
10. (Animal Sculpture) Sculptures in the feature category can be a creation depicting any kind of animal or bird.
11. All entries are included in the open section. One prize per person in the open section will be awarded. One prize in each of the feature categories will be awarded. An entrant is eligible to win more than one of each of the feature categories if entered. All entrants are eligible for the people's choice award as well as participating residents for the locals award.
12. Previous entries or modified entries from other years (WMFD Victorian Farm Sculpture Competitions) will not be accepted. Sculptures do not necessarily have to have been made in the last 12 months.
13. Entries will be judged on the use of agricultural/farm/rural materials and their creativity individuality, uniqueness, work time/skill involved and compliance with entry conditions.
14. Sculptures must be weatherproof as the display will be outdoors and open to the public.
15. WMFD will tag and number each entry upon arrival including all pieces if a sculpture has multiple parts
16. Sculptures are to be delivered to Field Days site between 9.30am- 4pm of the week preceding the Field Days (Feb 27th to Mar 4th) closing 12 noon 04/03/17. Judging will commence at 1pm Sat 4th March 2017.
17. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
18. The Farm Sculpture display area (inside the Field Days site) will be roped off prior to the Field Days event. Overnight site security will be in place at the Field Days from the Thursday before and to the Friday after the Field Days. No security will be in place outside these days (and nights)
19. Entries will be showcased at the 2017 Wimmera Machinery Field Days and are to remain available each day for display from 7-9 March. The entrant agrees to photographic reproduction and other media forms of the sculpture for future promotions by WMFD.
20. All Farm Sculpture entrants receive a FREE double adult pass to the Field Days for Thursday. Awards and presentations to all Farm Sculpture winners will be made around 11am Thursday 9th March 2017.
21. All entrants are responsible for the collection of their works after 4.30 pm on the final day of the Field Days. The Field Days will be open for collection also from 8am Friday 10th March.
22. The Wimmera Machinery Field Days will exercise every care when handling sculptures and for the security of sculptures during display dates but will not be held responsible for any loss or damage.
